How we select winners

iLeukout has an independent panel of judges who read the nomination forms, and selects finalists. The first award date is December 25th 2016, and the deadline to submit your two documents are on December 10th 2016 at 11:59PM Central Time. Award amounts will be determined on the award date. Please be advised that by providing information, you are also well aware of our privacy policy.

One (1) patient will be selected from University Medical Center Health System, Lubbock Texas (UMC). Another (1) patient will be selected from the University of Alabama at Birmingham Comprehensive Cancer Center (UAB). Three (3) patients will be selected from any other location in the United States.
